Emily Evans Scholarship Application

Deadline: Postmarked by May 31, 2021

Scholarship Program Criteria

Kendyl and Friends Foundation, Inc has established annual scholarships for students pursuing their Master's with a specialization in Clinical Mental Health Counseling for children. An individual is eligible to apply for a one-year scholarship for educational-related expenses if he or she meets the established criteria. The scholarship amounts will vary depending on individual needs, yearly budget, and number of applications.

Eligibility Requirements

- Currently enrolled in, or accepted into a Master's through an accredited college or university, as a degree-seeking student in Clinical Mental Health Counseling with the intent to work with children.
- Demonstrates a commitment to serve rural areas in Kentucky
- Demonstrates leadership abilities through participation in community service
- Cumulative college GPA of 3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale. Both overall and in the chosen area of study
- Demonstrate a need for financial assistance

Instructions for Completing this Scholarship Application

Please complete this application by typing or printing legibly. Only completed and signed applications postmarked by the deadline will be considered.

1. Copy of your most recent transcript from current or last college or university attended. An official transcript is required by the May 31, 2021 application deadline.
2. Minimum of three original letters of recommendation from individuals who are not related to you, the applicant. One letter of recommendation must be from a faculty advisor. At least one letter of recommendation should reflect your interest to work with children in Clinical Mental Health Counseling. All letters of recommendation must be in original form, and must be signed and addressed to the Emily Evans Scholarship Committee at the address noted below.
3. In a separate document, please specify your involvement, and dates of participation in community service and volunteer involvement, and any honors or awards you have received.
4. In a separate document, please prepare a personal narrative, not to exceed 2,500 words, indicating your interest in and commitment to children's Clinical Mental Health Counseling, your career goals, examples of your involvement in your rural community, financial need for assistance, and why you feel you should be selected as a recipient of this scholarship.
5. Provide a letter of acceptance into a Master's through an accredited college or university, as a degree-seeking student in Clinical Mental Health Counseling.
6. Provide a copy of your completed Student Aid Report (SAR). This is obtained after filing your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
